

## **Collection of Industrial Manufacturing Drugs in the Hispanic Pharmacy Museum (UCM)**

The emergence of industrial manufacturing of drugs is not only a substantial change in drug development, but also an important transformation of the pharmaceutical environment. The match between aesthetics and function, present in the pharmacy offices while drug was a handmade production, evolves to a new concept in which packages and filing forms gain prominence. In order to reconcile the museological values with the interest for history of therapeutics, intrinsic to this type of material, a specific museological treatment is required. In the poster we will make a presentation of the 3,153 drugs that make up the collection of the Hispanic Pharmacy Museum and the proceeding used for its inventory and catalogation.
